Shin Yu Wang is a Taiwanese-Canadian French horn player who is currently in the process of completing her Bachelor's degree in Performance at the University of Toronto, where she studies with Gabriel Radford, the third horn of the Toronto Symphony Orchestra. Despite the global pandemic, Shin is still participating in various musical projects remotely. With the National Youth Orchestra of Canada's zoom masterclasses in the summer, small chamber groups preparing to premiere young composers' works in the near future, and current recording projects such as sound memos for a virtual walk-through sound gallery with video game designs; Shin continues to expand her skills in and outside of being a musician.

Having performed with multiple professional and amateur orchestras as a horn player, singer, and pianist, Shin is an active member of the music community. Shin has been a member of numerous symphony orchestras, the most recent being the University of Toronto Symphony Orchestra, the Toronto Youth Symphony Orchestra, the Vancouver Youth Symphony Orchestra, and the Langley Fine Arts Orchestra, most of which she held the principal position with for numerous consecutive years. Aside from her expertise in horn, Shin obtained her level 10 Royal Conservatory of Music Exam for piano in 2014, and she collaborates with diverse ensembles and teaches young aspiring musicians.
